



CONGRESS OF HOUSTON TEACHERS **2010 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

The Kathleen Davern scholarship fund was established from a bequest made to CHT by Kathleen Davern, a retired HISD teacher and member of CHT. This year, the Congress of Houston Teachers will award ten \$1500 scholarships to children of CHT members, including one \$1500 student scholarship to be awarded in the name of Dick Miller and his wife Jeanette. Dick was a long-time HISD teacher, past CHT President and first CHT Executive Director. Also, ten \$500 scholarships will be awarded to HISD educators who are CHT members, including one funded by Dearborn & Creggs Investments and one funded as a memorial gift by the family of CHT founding member Renee Feeney.

Guidelines for ALL Scholarship Applicants

- All completed applications must be sent by U.S. mail and postmarked by **April 1, 2010**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications submitted by e-mail, by fax, or in person will not be considered.
- The CHT Executive Board will determine the winners after reviewing applications. Winners will be notified by phone.
- Scholarship winners will be announced at the CHT banquet, **May 3, 2010**, and scholarships will be funded when proof of registration and receipts are presented. Scholarship money must be used before **June 1, 2011** and is specifically designated for tuition, fees, books, and technology required for coursework.
- Each student winner and one parent may attend the CHT banquet as our guests. Educator winners may also attend the CHT banquet as our guests. Winners will receive a formal invitation and may purchase tickets for additional guests they wish to bring.

Additional Guidelines for STUDENT Scholarship Applicants

- Each student applicant is required to submit an application and an essay of 50 words or less indicating why he or she is deserving of a CHT scholarship.
- Each student applicant is also required to submit an official sealed transcript.
